People with a disability who require assistance to access community venues and activities have a right to equal participation in the community.

The introduction of the Companion Card means fairer ticketing for people with a disability who require a companion.

Holders of the Companion Card will now be issued a second ticket for their companion, at no charge, to a range of community activities.

It also gives venues and events an easy way to comply with some of their obligations under existing disability discrimination legislation.
